Introduction

- A. Big Idea: God gives his people a meal to share so they will remember his work of salvation.
- B. Type— "A person, practice, or event from the Old Testament that sets the pattern for salvation in Christ" (Philip Graham Ryken)
- I. Who Is to Eat the Meal? (12:43-49)
 - A. 1 Corinthians 11:27-28
 - B. We cannot have communion with Christ unless we have faith in his blood.
- II. How Is the Meal to Be Eaten? (12:47, 50)
 - A. In Unity (12:3-6, 46-47, 50-51)
 - 1. The meal was to eaten at the same time.
 - 2. To have union with Christ is to have communion with his church.
 - B. In Purity (13:3-7; 1 Corinthians 5:6-8)
- III. Why Is the Meal to Be Eaten?
 - A. So we can remember. (13:3, 9; 12:14; 1 Corinthians 11:23-25)
 - B. So we can instruct others. (13:8; 12:26-27; 1 Corinthians 11:26)
 - C. So we can encourage one another. (Luke 22:14–18; Revelation 19:6-9; Ephesians 5:22-32)
