Exodus 14:1-14

Memory Verses: Romans 8:38-39

Big Idea: God saves his people for his own glory.

I. God Issues a Divine Decree (14:1-4)

- A. The God who delivers us is in complete control of every detail.
- B. There is nothing Satan can do to thwart God’s plan (Job 42:2; Psalm 115:3).
- C. Nothing can separate us from God’s saving love (Romans 8:35-39).

II. God Requires a Personal Response to His Plan (14:5-12)

- A. “Nor is violence offered to the will of the creature, nor yet is the liberty or contingency of second causes taken away, but rather established” (Second London Confession of Faith, chapter 3, article 1).
- B. You are responsible for the decisions you make.
- C. Don’t confuse superficial change with supernatural conversion.

III. God Proclaims a Message to His People (14:13-14)

- A. Fear not. Stand firm. See the salvation of the LORD.
- B. 2 Timothy 3:16-17
- C. God tells us who he is and what he is doing.
- D. God saves us and tells us what to do in the Bible.
