- I. God Is Glorified by Saving His People (14:15-22)
 - A. God is sovereign over us and his enemies (14:15-18).
 - (1) Understanding can wait but obedience cannot.
 - (2) Philippians 2:9-11
 - B. God is our defender (14:19-20).
 - (1) Isaiah 63:9b
 - (2) Psalm 91
 - (3) "The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and delivers them" (Psalm 34:7).
 - (4) Ephesians 6:10-17
 - C. God is our deliverer (14:21-22).

- II. God Is Glorified by Judging His Enemies (14:23-28)
