Big Idea: God designed human sexuality and marriage for his glory and human flourishing.

- I. God Created Marriage, Not Man (Genesis 2:18)
  - A. Genesis 1:26-28
  - B. "Helper"—16 of 19 times in the Old Testament this word refers to God. (Psalm 10:14)
  - C. "Fit"—like opposite
  - D. Complementarianism—God created men and women as equals but he has given men and women different roles to fulfill in the marriage relationship.
  - E. "Marriage is a sacred bond between a man and a woman, instituted by and publicly entered into before God, normally consummated by sexual [intimacy]" (Andreas Kostenberger).
- II. God Gives and Governs Our Desire for Marriage (Genesis 2:19-23)
  - A. God gives us the desire to get married.
  - B. God governs our desire for marriage.
    - 1. God made a woman for Adam.
    - 2. Christian, marry a Christian. (2 Corinthians 6:14; 1 Corinthians 7:39)
- III. God Designed Marriage to Be the Highest of All Earthly Relationships (Genesis 2:24-25)
  - A. Four principles of marriage
    - 1. Severance
    - 2. Permanence
    - 3. Unity
    - 4. Intimacy
  - B. Marriage is designed to portray the gospel. (Ephesians 5:31-32)
