Acts 1:1-14

Memory Verse: Acts 1:8

Introduction

- A. Our Mission Statement: We exist to glorify God by making disciples through the gospel, in community, on mission.
- B. Big Idea: Jesus commands every Christian to be his witness through the power of the Holy Spirit.
- C. If we're going to fulfill the Great Commission, that is our gospel mission, we need some things.
- I. We Need a Faith That Produces Obedience (1:1-7)
 - A. Luke 24:44-49
 - B. Our primary calling is not to ministry; it's to intimacy.
 - C. Gospel ministry flows out of the overflow of our intimacy with God.
 - D. "Through whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of his name among all the nations" (Rom 1:5).
- II. We Need a Passion That Produces Unity (1:8-14)
 - A. "All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and his brothers" (1:14).
 - B. Matthew 6:33
 - C. Kingdom of God—God's sovereign activity in the world resulting in people being in a right relationship with him.
- III. We Need a Desperation That Produces Prayer (1:8–14)
 - A. Prayer is not supplemental; it is fundamental.
 - B. "The church advances on her knees" (Leonard Ravenhill).
 - C. "The tragedy of the hour is the situation is desperate, but the saints are not" (Vance Havner).
- IV. We Need the Holy Spirit Who Produces Power (1:8)
 - A. Power—the life-changing dynamic of the Holy Spirit operating through the proclamation of the gospel.
 - B. "Filled with the Holy Spirit" is used 14 times in the Book of Acts. Ten of those refer to the present era.
 - C. Each time a person or a group of people was filled with the Holy Spirit they immediately began to witness powerfully for Jesus Christ.
 - D. One sure evidence of the power of the Holy Spirit in people's lives is that they testify to Jesus.
