#### Introduction

- A. Background
  - 1. Samaritans were descendants of the former Kingdom of Israel who intermarried with Assyrians.
  - 2. Jews and Samaritans did not like each other.
  - 3. Their hatred for each other led the Samaritans to have their own temple, Pentateuch, and they avoided worshiping in the temple in Jerusalem.
  - 4. Jews avoided passing through Samaria as much as possible.
- B. Big Idea: The New Testament church will be identified by a worship that is done in spirit and truth.

## I. What is spiritual worship?

- A. One aspect of spiritual worship is that it is a byproduct of love for God and His law.
  - 1. Romans 12:1
  - 2. Romans 5:7-8
  - 3. John 14:15
- B. Another aspect of spiritual worship is that it cannot be seen.
  - 1. Truth and Grace Catechism, Book 1, Question 9: Who is God? God is a spirit and does not have a body like men.
  - 2. John 4:24 \*Memory Verse\*
- C. A third and final aspect of spiritual worship is that it can be done everywhere.
  - 1. John 4:21
  - 2. 1 Peter 2:5

## II.What is truthful worship?

- A. Our worship must conform to the revelation of God in Scripture.
  - 1. John 4:22
  - 2. 2 Timothy 3:16-17
- B. Our hearts need boundaries. Worship cannot just be what we feel.
  - 3. Jeremiah 17:9
