- A. The LORD showed mercy to Abraham and Abimelech by taking action against Abimelech. (20:3-7)
- B. The LORD affirmed Abraham's position before him to Abimelech during the dream despite Abraham's sinful behavior. (20:7)

II. God Is Faithful (20:3-16)

C. The LORD worked despite
Abraham's foolish choices, unbelief,
fear, and the predicament he had
gotten himself into. (20:7)

D. The LORD used an unbeliever's rebuke to expose a believer's sin. (20:8-16)

The gospel is the good news that the just and gracious God of the universe looked upon hopelessly sinful people and sent His only son, Jesus Christ, God in human flesh to bare his wrath against sin on the cross and to show his power over sin in the resurrection, so that, all who turn from their sin and put their faith in him can be reconciled to the Father forever.
