Seven Implications

- 1. God had already made his will known. (Genesis 25:23)
- 2. God's revelation calls for trust and obedience.
- 3. Isaac should have had a higher view of God's covenant than to entrust it to Esau.
- 4. Presumption and neglect negatively affect all of us.
- 5. Jacob's own deceitfulness followed him.
- 6. Esau's remorse was not true repentance. (Hebrews 12:16-17)
- 7. God is not constrained or held hostage by the schemes of man. (Acts 2:23-24)

Two Life-Changing Realities

- 1. We are to live by divine revelation. (Matthew 6:4)
- 2. We experience chaos when we reject divine revelation. (Proverbs 29:18)
