1. The Inevitability of Jesus' Second Coming

- So much of the Bible is about the coming One
 - One fifth of the Bible is Prophetic
 - One third of those prophecies refers to the Second Coming of Christ
 - There are over 660 general prophecies in the Bible
 - 333 refer to Chris
 - 109 refer to His first coming
 - 224 refer to His second coming
 - 1500 OT passages refer to Christ's second coming.
 - This is 1 out of every 25 NT verses
 - For every 1 verse about His first coming, there are 8 verses about His second coming.
- There are many reasons why Christ must come again
 - Promises of God demand it!
 - Promises of Christ demand it
 - Promises of the Holy Spirit demand it
 - o Promises of the angels demand it
 - Promises of the apostles demand it
