- I. God Created Marriage (2:18)
 - A. Cultural Mandate (1:28)
 - B. "Helper"—16 out of 19 times in the Old Testament this word refers to God.
 - C. "Fit"—like opposite
 - D. Complementarianism
 - E. Marriage is a sacred bond (covenant) between a man and a woman, instituted by and publicly entered into before God, normally consummated by sexual intercourse." (Dr. Andreas Kostenberger)
- II. God Gives and Governs Our Desire for Marriage (2:19-23)
 - A. God gives us the desire to get married.
 - B. God governs our desire for marriage.
 - 1. God made a woman for Adam to marry.
 - 2. Marry a Christian. (2 Corinthians 6:14; 1 Corinthians 7:39)
- III. God Designed Marriage to Be the Highest of All Earthly Relationships (2:24-25)
 - A. Four Principles of Marriage
 - 1. Severance ("Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother")
 - 2. Permanence ("and hold fast to his wife")
 - 3. Unity ("and they shall become one flesh")
 - 4. Intimacy ("And the man and his wife were both naked and were not ashamed.")
 - B. Ephesians 5:31-32.
